SENIOR TECHNICIAN: TECHNICAL OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE AND PROJECTS (ELECTRICAL)

at uShaka Sea World's Technical Department

The responsibilities will include:

- To ensure the continuous operation of Life Support System (LSS) equipment and systems, by conducting mechanical, electrical and instrumentation maintenance on all LSS equipment and plant, as and when assigned to do so by the assistant manager.
- To ensure the reliability of SAAMBR's vehicles through regular inspections and maintenance.
- To assist with LSS operations, as and when assigned to do so.

Requirements for the position are:

- Matric is essential.
- A Trade Test Certificate in Electrical or Millwright is essential.
- A Diploma in Electrical Engineering is essential.
- Supervisory management certification (or demonstrable experience) is essential.
- Proven/Evidence-based 3-5 years in a supervisory/foreman role.
- 5 to 10 years of plant experience is essential (preferably in a water treatment environment).
- A competent level of understanding of the Labour Law and its implementation is essential.
