Senior Technician: Maintenance (Re-advertised)

The responsibilities will include:

- To supervise the daily maintenance of all Sea World equipment and plant.
- To supervise maintenance staff, in conjunction with the Assistant Manager: Maintenance.
- Prioritise use of human, physical and financial resources to achieve departmental goals.
- To assume the responsibilities of the Assistant Manager: Maintenance in his absence.
- To ensure effective and timely maintenance of all plant and equipment by service providers.
- To ensure the maximum availability of plant and equipment, by performing timely planned maintenance.
- To ensure that all maintenance work is performed safely, according to all relevant legislation, SAAMBR Standard Operating Procedures, and Best Practices in industry.

The following will be required of the successful candidate:

- A minimum of 5 years mechanical maintenance experience in an industrial environment.
- More relevant mechanical maintenance experience will be a distinct advantage.
- A qualified artisan with a valid mechanical trade test certificate, either Millwright, or Mechanical Fitter, is essential.
- Good interpersonal and communication skills and experience.
- Ideally will have completed some supervisory programmes or courses, but is not essential.
- Good organisational skills and communication skills.
- Proven experience supervising artisans thereby always ensuring maximum plant and equipment availability and efficiency.
- Proven experience coordinating plant and equipment breakdowns and outages, always ensuring maximum plant availability.
- Basic proficiency in MS Office packages, such as MS Excel, and MS Word is also essential.
- Willing to learn and assist with tasks not generally associated with mechanical maintenance, (e.g. electrical and instrumentation maintenance) will be a distinct advantage.
