Junior Audio-Visual Technician – Mammals & Birds
(3-month fixed term contract - average of 3 days a week)

The candidate will be required to perform tasks related to AV and videography during dolphin and seal show times in the Mammals and Birds Department, under the supervision of senior animal care staff.

The responsibilities will include:

- Execute all technical aspects of live events/shows for the Mammal & Bird department, in accordance with professional production standards.
- Carry out the preparation, operation and maintenance of equipment and associated activities safely, according to the OHS Act and in-house standard operating procedures.
- Perform administrative and departmental support duties including husbandry.

The following will be required of the successful applicant:

- Matric (Grade 12).
- AV and Audio knowledge within a corporate and outdoor AV environment.
- MS Office proficient to enable document handling.
- Basic PC troubleshooting.
- Basic knowledge of equipment, practices and safety standards including their application to live events installations.
- Must have worked on corporate and outdoor events
- Must have experience with capture of live footage of animals
- Able to work well in a team environment.

- An excellent command of the English language.
- Competent swimming ability- an in-house swim test needs to be passed.
